Personal Property	Equipment Placement on Sidewalks and Terraces	9.54(1)	(1) No person shall place, set up, construct, or allow to remain a table, easel, case, crate, box, stand, tent, rack, cart, or any other equipment, display or articles of any kind on a public sidewalk or sidewalk area, terrace, street or highway right-of-way, except temporarily while actively loading or unloading such items, or unless a T permit or E permit has been issued under this section, or unless such equipment placement is authorized, by permit or other authorization, elsewhere in these ordinances.	16
Motor Bus Shelter	Motor Bus Shelter - Lawful Use	11.03	(1) No person shall enter or remain in a bus shelter or at a transfer point except while actually waiting for the arrival of the next scheduled bus routed to the person's destination or except while having business to attend to in connection with waiting for a bus. (2) No citation may be issued for a violation of this subsection unless the area has been posted with an official sign which notifies the person not to enter or remain on the premises. (3) This section does not prohibit any person from entering or remaining in a bus shelter in an emergency situation or for a brief period of time to seek protection from the elements.	19

Evidence of lodging shall include but not be limited to bedrolls, mattresses, blankets, cooking utensils, clothing, and other personal belongings.	16
	Temporary Structure Prohibited Without Permit	8.26	(1) No person, group or corporation may erect, build, maintain or store any temporary structure in any City park without first paying a fee and receiving a permit to erect, build, maintain or store same. Temporary structure shall include but not be limited to any staging platforms, tents, buildings, trailers, bleachers or similar non City supplied items. Each such structure shall require a separate permit. This provision shall not apply to any temporary structure which has a base area of sixty (60) square feet and a height of five (5) feet or less.	0
